

CSS Flexible Short-Term Fund Categories of Requests

Equipment (see sub-categories below)

In all cases it must be an item not covered by the Ontario Assistive Devices Program.

- **Mobility Aids**

- Commodes, tilt commodes, commode chairs
- Reachers
- Lift chairs
- Pelvic belts and lateral support belts
- Transfer discs and boards
- Walkers not covered by ADP or client portion (25%) of walker covered by ADP

- **Medical Equipment**

- Hospital beds
- Specialized beds (eg bariatric)
- Mattresses
- Rails and castors
- Medication dispensers
- ROHO cushions
- Specialized humidifiers

- **Bath & Shower Aids**

- Benches
- Chairs
- Bath lifts
- Grab bars
- Raised toilet seat
- Shower pole

- **Lifts and lift accessories**

- Lifts (hoyer, ceiling, XY, portable, etc)
- Stair lifts
- Tracks for lifts
- Slings and other accessories

- **Wheelchairs**

- Client portion of wheelchair or scooter (25% of total cost not covered by ADP)
- Wheelchair modifications
- Wheelchair repairs

CSS Flexible Short-Term Fund Categories of Requests

- **Accessible Technology**
 - Communication devices
 - Hearing
 - Language (anti-stuttering devices, call bells, adaptive telephones)
 - Speech
 - To support access to virtual programming
- **Miscellaneous Equipment**
 - Batteries
 - Equipment repairs
 - Weighted utensils
 - Emergency alert systems
 - Doorway alert kits
 - Slide sheets
 - Overbed tables
 - Accessible technology (eg. Communication devices)

PSW Support

- Short term increased support due to temporary illness/injury of the primary caregiver
- Temporary additional staffing (eg. PSW) for personal care needs
- Double staffing for temporary increase in need or to address a safety issue

Home Renovations

- Renovations that address a H&S need or prevent LTC home placement
- Renovations (eg bathroom conversion such as tub to shower or widening a doorway) that address an accessibility need
- Ramps
- Porch lifts
- Door openers

Other

- Move
 - relocation of a client to address a H&S need
 - transporting equipment to client location
- Deep clean / hoarding / decluttering to address a H&S issue
- Pest removal services to address infestation that causes a H&S issue (eg cockroaches)
